SAINT THOMAS ACADEMY CADETS AND COACH SELECTED FOR ALL-STAR FOOTBALL GAME

MENDOTA HEIGHTS, Minn., April 2, 2008 – Saint Thomas Academy announced today that seniors F. Waldvogel and J. Stodolka, both of Mendota Heights, will represent the All-Metro Football team in the annual All-Star Game to be held Saturday, June 28, 2008, at St. Cloud State University. The Academy's Varsity Football Coach Dave Ziebarth was selected to coach the All-Metro team for this game.

While Stodolka and Waldvogel were starters as juniors and seniors, the Cadets went 21-4. In 2006, the Cadets were conference and section champions, and finished second in the 2006 Prep Bowl. In 2007, the team was second in the conference and the section.

Waldvogel holds four school records: longest punt return for a touchdown (95 yards), longest kick-off return for a touchdown (97 yards), most career receptions and most receptions in a season.

Stodolka anchored the offensive line at the center position for his junior and senior year. During those two years, the offense averaged more than 35 points a game.
