

FOUR SAINT THOMAS ACADEMY STUDENTS NAMED AP RISING SCHOLARS

The Minnesota Advanced Placement Advisory Council (MNAPAC) traditionally honors students who have graduated with the title of "Rising Scholar." In Minnesota, more than 30,000 students took almost 50,000 exams at 283 different schools; only 2,200 students were named AP Rising Scholars.
